Winemaker Notes: The 2009 Cabernet Sauvignon shows great depth and structure. Our vines were farmed meticulously maintaining the proper amount of cluster/clusters for each individual shoot. This technique produces a very intense wine that captures the flavors of the site. There are aromas of blackberry, anise, cocoa and wood smoke, which continue on the palate with the flavor of black cherry. Optimum harvesting produces soft, silky wines with rich tannins that will continue to develop with age, but are approachable when young.

Optimum storage conditions: constant temperatures 55 to 58°F, darkness

Aging potential: To enjoy young fruit aromas, consume within 1 to 3 years of bottling date. For extended aging under ideal conditions, consume within 3 to 10 years of bottling date.
