Winemaker Notes: The 2009 Syrah shows bright aromas along with great structure. Our vines were farmed meticulously maintaining the proper amount of cluster/clusters for each shoot. This technique produces a very intense wine that captures the flavors of our site. Classic aromas of boysenberry and blackberry with a smokey accent dominate the wine, while cranberry, blackberry flavors and refined tannins round out the flavors and finish.

Optimum storage conditions: constant temperatures 55 to 58°F, darkness

Aging potential: To enjoy young fruit aromas, consume within 1 to 3 years of bottling date. For extended aging under ideal conditions, consume within 3 to 10 years of bottling date.
