



## 2019 Syrah – Paso Robles

Vintage: 2019

Varietal: 94% Syrah, 6% Petite Sirah

Appellation: Paso Robles, Creston

**Winemaker Notes:** The 2019 Syrah shows bright aromas along with great structure. Our vines were farmed meticulously, maintaining the proper number of clusters for each individual shoot. This technique produces a very intense wine that captures the flavors of our site.

Aromas of boysenberry and spice and a smokey accent dominate the wine, the flavor of blackberry and refined tannins round out the flavors and finish.

Optimum storage conditions: constant temperatures 55 to 58°F, darkness

Aging potential: For extended aging under ideal conditions, consume within 3-10 years of bottling date.

Fermented in 1.5 ton bins
